

The School of Veterinary Medicine at National Taiwan University has one faculty vacancy (on animal histology) to be filled on 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2016. The candidate is expected to teach animal histology, those with experiences in morphology, TEM and SEM being the priority choice. The candidate must have a biomedical or veterinary Ph.D. degree with at least one representative full paper, in which he/she serves as the first or corresponding author, published by a SCI-listed journal (or Ph.D. dissertation) after 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2011. The starting levels, from assistant to full professor, will be commensurate with the candidate's qualifications. Application package must include 3 copies of the curriculum vitae, 1 copy of ID card (or passport) , 1 copy of the degree diploma, 3 letters of recommendation, 3 copies of the representative publication (see above) together with verification of co-author's contribution to the applicant's representative publication (form available upon request), three copies of a maximum of 5 additional publications within the past 7 years, 3 copies of the publication list, 1 copy of the title and outline of the courses to be offered.
