

The School of Veterinary Medicine at the National Taiwan University seeks applications for one full time faculty member at the rank of Instructor or above in large animal and wild animal medicine. Applicant with large animal medicine or wild animal medicine experience or residency training is preferred. The position includes responsibilities for undergraduate and postgraduate teaching. Faculty rank and salary are commensurate with the candidate's professional qualifications. The position will start at 1st of February 2016.

Minimum qualifications include DVM degree, Ph.D. degree, and veterinarian certificate required for application include:

1. Three copies of curriculum vitae and one copy of ID card (or passport)
2. One copy of the degree certificate
3. One copy of veterinarian certificate of R.O.C.(or other country)
4. Three reference letters
5. Three copies of a representative publication

The publication must fulfill one of the following requirements.

(a) A full research article published after 1st February 2011 in a SCI-listed journal.

The applicant must serve as the first author or the corresponding author for the article. A verification letter of the co-author's contribution to the article should also be accompanied. Or

(b) The applicant's Ph.D. dissertation finished after 1st February 2011.

6. Three copies of other scientific publications within the past seven years (maximum five publications)
7. Three copies of a publication list
8. Three copies of the title and lecture outline of a teaching subject
9. Document of clinical experience in small animal medicine, such as certificate of residency training or diplomate certification
